- **Dr. Richard Falzone – McLean's Hospital, Belmont, Massachusetts, USA**
- **Criminal Negligence →**

During this time period when there are gross lesions in the brain and spine there is clear negligence in a medical setting in Mclean's Hospital, Belmont Massachusetts. This is medical mistreatment during medical negligence.

There are several inpatient hospitalizations and all medications prescribed in this setting have no positive response and don't reduce the inflammation in the brain or spinal column leaving the patient (me) in severe physical pain due to brain and cervical spine lesions (inflammation). The cervical spine lesions cause constant physical pain along the head and the lower spinal lesions cause pain along the physical extremities (it feels like placing a person limbs on a stove and keeping them there).

The negligence and mismedication was later found to be intentional for the sake of malice in a medical setting.

The doctors and neurologists in the hospital appear to understand that there is no medically possible way that the medications prescribed would cause a positive response and they didn't produce any response with repeated trials. The lack of appropriate medication under neurology and toxicology eventuates in a prominent neurological injury to the cervical spine, brain, and optic nerves. I have had progressive MS since at least 2008 (MS where the disease progresses and causes neurological injury through mistreatment).

The case against this hospital and the doctor in the setting (Dr. Falzone) is protracted due to the number of instances of fraud that took place thereafter that result in neurological injury.

With repeated attempts at fraud and negligence in a medical settings from that point it could be assumed that the doctors in this setting originated the pattern of medical falsification to avoid consequence of medical negligence or mistreatment. They try to hide the features of neurological damage by falsifying diagnostic reports which is subsequently acknowledge by the treating physicians. Its more then 14 instances of fraud in medical settings with the intent of causing harm and the non trivial nature of it happens in repeated instances, the criminal fraud and mistreatment continues today.

It should be noted that with large lesions in the brain and spine, there is no way that the condition could ever be typified as a "psychiatric condition". It could only be treated under neurology, neuroimmunology, neurotoxicology, and toxicology.

The treating physician (Dr. Falzone) himself is illogical and doesn't seem to understand basis in medicine or why the medications he prescribed could never be effective (they notably weren't by his own acknowledgement). He also doesn't seem to understand consequence of medical mistreatment in conditions that effect the central nervous system and how neurological damage presents.
