Diagnosis

1. Multiple sclerosis Confirmed diagnosis

Follow Up: Mr Jana is a 35 year old gentleman who presented with a flare up of his typical MS symptoms. Presented with Upper back pain along with reduced motor and sensory function of left upper limb along with reduced sensory function of left lower limb. Additionally he had typical pains originating from lower back radiating down right inner thigh through to the toes. Patient is currently undergoing rituximab therapy 6 monthly and has noticed improvement in his symptoms since. Typically when flare ups occur, Mr Jana presents to Emergency departments and received methylprednisolone IV with preceding blood tests on an outpatient basis to cover for a 3 weekly period. Upon discussion with senior ED registrar, we advised Mr Jana that this is not normal protocol for an emergency department and the best suited action would be to visit his GP and be referred onto an appropriate specialist for further management for his MS. Please can GP follow up for further management of Mr Jana's symptoms.
